How to apply

Obtained a 1st, 2:1 or 2:2 undergraduate degree?

- Your degree can be in any discipline.
- You must have obtained a 1st, 2:1 or 2:2 undergraduate degree by end of July 2019.
- If your degree was not obtained in the UK, it must be the equivalent of a UK degree and meet our minimum grade.

You are eligible to apply if you have been educated to degree level, regardless of the year of graduation.

We positively encourage all applicants to self-identify their characteristics in the equal opportunities monitoring section in the application. Got the eligibility to work in the UK?
