- Undertake annual and renewal yacht code surveys for **commercial yachts** against the requirements of the Large Yacht Code (LY1, LY2, LY3, Reg Code and PYC).
- Undertake inspections and surveys on Manx fishing vessels and other locally operating craft.
- Assist clients and **provide advice** to owners and managers on all technical issues relating to the operation of ships and yachts registered in the Isle of Man.
- **Assist** the Principal Surveyor on duty with day to day enquiries and administrative work.
