

Job Description Housekeeper

Role Summary

To support the Registered Managers in the upkeep of the children's home at MacIntyre School Wingrave with specific responsibilities for general maintenance, housekeeping and cleaning to provide a high quality and homely environment.

Working with the Registered Managers the support teams within the children's home and our facilities team you will ensure that the environments that young people live in are homely, clean and reflect the interests and personalities of the young people that live there. You will ensure that there is a quick response to any damage to furnishings to ensure that environments remain in good order. You will support the staff teams within the home to achieve and maintain high quality living environments across the whole children's' home. You will ensure that good quality furnishings are resourced and purchased as required.

You will be accountable to a Registered Manager

Our job descriptions are all written with the following four key points about MacIntyre in mind:

1. Our Vision

For all people with a learning disability to live a life that makes sense to them.

2. Our Mission

We will support a sense of wellbeing through a celebration of each person's unique gifts, talents and contributions, the quality of our relationships and ensuring the promotion of real opportunities to connect with others.

3. Our purpose

To achieve excellence in everything we do.

MacIntyre's "primary purpose" is to make a positive contribution to the lives of children and adults with disabilities. We make this contribution by ensuring that all our interactions are great, that our knowledge and skills represent excellence and that we support people to develop purposeful and warm relationships. Our "secondary purpose" is to have a positive influence in our local communities and on our sector by connecting well, nurturing partnerships and demonstrating best practice.

4. Our DNA

MacIntyre has a particular way of working with people and because it is so important to all our activities we call it our DNA. It is a combination of our values and the way that we put those values into actions that is unique to MacIntyre. Through our Promises and Value Base, the promotion of Great Interactions™ and Person Centred Approaches, we aim to support every person to live a life that makes sense to them, with a level and style of support of their choosing.

Responsibilities

You will be required to carry out a range of duties within your role. The key responsibilities are detailed below but there will be other duties consistent with the role that you may be requested to undertake by your line manager.

The Young People We Support and our Staff

- 1. To supervise the part-time School Cook who works in the school building.
- 2. Ensure that the houses are maintained to a high standard of presentation whilst upholding children's rights to privacy, dignity and choice.
- 3. Safely and correctly store cleaning chemicals and equipment adhering to COSHH regulations at all times
- 4. In partnership with staff team and young people ensure that the interest/ likes and personalities of young people living in the children's home are reflected in the dcor, soft furnishings
- 5. By sourcing and using high quality furnishings that are well maintained create an ambiance and atmosphere within the children's home that shows an attention to detail and care placed on the living environment for our young people
- 6. To have oversight and coordination of the menu planning and quality and the nutritional value of the food within the children's home
- 7. To maintain Health and Safety precautions in all working areas and to comply with good practice, policies and procedures as laid down in the Health and Safety Policy, with particular regard to COSHH, Risk Assessments, Electricity at Work, Safe Systems at Work, Manual Handling, safe use of Hazardous substances, etc

Quality

- 8. Ensure that the internal decorations and furnishings promote a homely environment and reflect the choices and personalities of the young people living there.
- 9. Working with the facilities team and registered manager ensure that all areas of the children's home have a decoration plan in place
- 10. Ensure that all furnishings both communal and personal to young people maintain a high quality and reflects a high standard
- 11. Where damage to furnishings does occur ensure that this is addressed and items are replaced/repaired quickly and if required reported to maintenance through Safe Smart
- 12. Maintain the required standard of cleaning services following the correct procedure and frequencies
- 13. Carry out and oversee specialist cleaning and one-off cleaning duties in line with service requirements
- 14. Coordinate the cleaning tasks across the children's home and monitor the standard of these
- 15. Work with staff teams, and young people to agree environment areas that require improvement and provide support to achieve this
- 16. If there are shortfalls in the standard and quality of the cleanliness and environmental hygiene within the children's home then address these directly with the staff team and the relevant registered manager

Sustainability

- 17. Replenish disposables and consumables relevant for the children's' home
- 18. To maintain good relationships with all other members of staff
- 19. To plan and organise and prioritise key tasks to ensure that there is a continual high standard of environment achieved in the children's' home
- 20. To attend training as appropriate and to keep all necessary skills up to date
- 21. To engage and participate in regular supervision with your line manager and performance appraisal review process
