Purpose of job

The Electrical Testing Engineer is responsible for undertaking five yearly electrical inspection testing to properties across the whole of Abri Group's housing stock, ensuring homes are safe and compliant. Utilising relevant software to complete appropriate certification, the role will also require the carrying out of Cat 1 and 2 repairs identified as part of the testing in accordance with NICEIC guidelines.

Key duties and responsibilities

- Carry out Electrical Testing in accordance with NICEIC guidelines to a range of properties across the operational area of Abri.
- Responsible for accurately completing an electrical test certificate for each property.
- Where electrical defects in the defined categories are identified, take the appropriate remedial measures to rectify ensuring properties and customers are safe.
- Provide a high-quality service to Abri customers, demonstrating excellent customer care principles at all times.
- Ensure at all times that works comply with relevant Health & Safety legislation, policies and procedures in the performance of the duties of the post, to include appropriate use of equipment, PPE and safety footwear.
- Cover out of hours emergency call out in accordance with the departmental rota or attend to emergencies out of hours when required (optional to this post).
- Carry out other reasonable duties and responsibilities within the overall function, commensurate with the grading and level of responsibilities of the post.

Knowledge, skills and experience required

- Level 3 Award (City & Guilds or equivalent) in the Requirements for Electrical Installations BS7671:2018 (2382-15) with the new amendment 3 qualification (BS7671:2018) or a fully time served electrician who carried out at least City & Guilds Level 2 & 3 Diploma in Electrical Installations (Buildings and Structures) or equivalent.
- Has achieved City & Guilds 2394 and 2395 in initial verification, certification, periodic inspection and testing of electrical installations (or equivalent qualification).
- Ability to record accurately the work undertaken, record hours, materials and costs.

- Driving licence and /or ability to travel in a timely and efficient manner to attend properties, frequently located in areas not covered by public transport.
